NORTHERN SAN DIEGANS STRONGLY OPPOSE A TOLL ROAD THROUGH POPULAR STATE PARK

For 15 years, the Save San Onofre Coalition (SSOC) fought to protect San Onofre State Beach from a destructive six-lane toll road. In Nov. 2016, this struggle, that included five lawsuits and countless public hearings, was resolved. A settlement agreement was reached that permanently protected San Onofre State Beach from this road proposal.

In spite of this historic settlement agreement, efforts to force a destructive road through one of California's most popular state parks continue.

A recent poll found that those in northern San Diego County strongly oppose a toll road through San Onofre State Beach – opposition that is strong across the board: young and old, male and female, and Republican, Democrat and Independent.



The area's Congressman has publicly made statements and voiced support for a scheme that would force a road through San Onofre State Beach.

That same poll found that, by an almost two-to-one-margin, those in the 49th Congressional District oppose the Congressman's threat to build a toll road through the state park.
